Only students eligible to enter an academy in the summer of 2027 should apply for a nomination at this time.

1. Complete the enclosed application form.
2. Submit a one-page list of extracurricular activities, including athletics, leadership roles, honors and awards, employment, etc.
3. Have a guidance counselor or principal complete the appropriate form and return it along with a copy of your high school transcript.
4. Submit THREE letters of recommendation (in addition to guidance counselor/principal's form). Give each recommender an "Instructions for Recommendations" sheet.
5. Submit a recent photograph or school picture.
6. Submit a one-page personal statement on "Why I want to attend a U.S. Service Academy."
7. You may also attach a brief explanation of any extraordinary or unusual personal or family circumstances that the Academy Selection Committee should consider.
8. Only students eligible to enter an academy in the summer of 2027 should apply for a nomination at this time.
9. Apply separately for admission to each academy in which you are interested.
10. Please TYPE the list of extracurricular activities and personal statement.

Admission to these academies is extremely limited, highly competitive, and an appointment is an esteemed honor and achievement. After successfully completing a rigorous four-year program in one of these competitive schools and receiving a first-rate education, a successful graduate will be pledged to serve a term as an officer in the Armed Forces.

To apply to a service academy, an applicant must obtain a nomination from an authorized source, and this applicant has requested a nomination from Congressman David Kustoff, Representative of the Eighth District of Tennessee. Congressman Kustoff and his Academy Selection Committee would appreciate your thorough and honest evaluation of the applicant's fitness for a U.S. Service admission and ensuing a military career. The academies consider evidence of character, scholarship, leadership, physical aptitude (athletic ability), medical fitness, goals, and motivation in determining each applicant's "whole person" evaluation.

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Before a candidate can receive an offer of appointment to a service academy, the candidate must obtain a nomination from an authorized source. Congressman David Kustoff is honored that as a U.S. Congressman, he is able to submit nominations from his constituency. A student can also apply for nominations through U.S. Senators, the President and the Vice President. If a parent is presently on active duty and has served in the military for at least eight years or is retired, a student may apply for a presidential nomination through the military. Children of deceased or disabled veterans or children of Medal of Honor winners may apply for a nomination directly from the service academies.

Acceptance of an offer of appointment from an academy involves at least a nine-year obligation to military service

– four years at the academy and five years of active duty service.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Each member of Congress may nominate only persons legally domiciled within the boundaries of his/her district.

If you are unsure of your district of residence, contact your local election commission.

Each member of Congress may nominate as many as ten students per each allotted vacancy to the Air Force, Military and Naval Academies.

Each member of Congress may nominate statewide, ten persons to compete for an appointment to the Merchant Marine Academy.

Nominations are not required for the U.S. Coast Guard Academy. A student applies directly to the Academy.

ACADEMY ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS: The Applicant **MUST**:

1. Be at least 17 years old but not have passed the 23rd birthday on July 1 of the year entering the academy (except the Merchant Marine Academy).
2. Be a U.S. Citizen.
3. Be unmarried, not pregnant and have no legal obligation to support children or other dependents (except for the Merchant Marine Academy).

NOMINATION PROCESS The Applicant **MUST**:

1. Apply for admission directly to each academy in which he/she is interested. The student must take the responsibility to contact the academy and complete a Pre-Candidate Questionnaire to begin the application process.
2. Complete an application package for Congressman David Kustoff's congressional nomination which this office provides.
3. Be interviewed by Congressman Kustoff's Academy Selection Committee.

GENERAL ACADEMY ADMISSIONS & NOMINATION STANDARDS

The Applicant **MUST**:

1. Have evidence of good moral character
2. Have record of acceptable scholastic achievement
3. Have participated in extracurricular activities
4. Be physically fit
5. Be medically qualified
6. Be motivated to attend the academy and serve in the Armed Forces

TIMELINE FOR THE NOMINATION PROCESS

Nomination applications are due on October 30, 2026 to Congressman Kustoff's Memphis office. Congressman Kustoff will then submit his nominations to the academies in January of 2027. Academies make all decisions on offers of appointment for admission during the spring of each year. Applicants will be notified of the academies' decision during this period. Final decision on admission rests with the academies. The new classes will enter in the summer.
